  - Highest Standing** -
    - students with the highest mark in grade 12 courses will receive a recognition award donated by an individual, group or business within the Ingersoll community
    - students with the highest standing in grade 9, 10 and 11 courses will receive a certificate
  - Honour Roll** - students achieving an 80%+ average overall in the school year will receive a certificate
    - Grades 9 and 10: all eight courses
    - Grade 11: best seven courses
    - Grade 12: best six courses
  - Ontario Scholar** – students achieving a grade of at least 80% in six grade 12 courses at the university, university/college, college, workplace, or open level will receive a certificate
- 4) There are symbols beside each award indicating which form of application is required. Please refer to the **LEGEND** page.
- 5) This booklet is accurate at date of printing, but awards may change. Updates will be posted on the electronic version of this booklet.
- 6) Many post-secondary institutions offer scholarships and bursaries, either automatically based on your average, or for which you must apply. Carefully check the website of your college/university for the latest updates and check with your institution's Financial Aid Office.

# How to Apply

Please read carefully

- Identify awards you qualify for, based on award criteria.
- Check which type of application form is required (see LEGEND on previous page).
- Download the **Generic Application Forms** at [www.tvdsb.ca/tvef](http://www.tvdsb.ca/tvef). Select AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS, then AWARDS DIRECTORY, then STUDENT AWARDS APPLICATION.
- The online generic form can be saved and changed as needed. Content of the 200-word essay should be customized based on the criteria for each award. Applications should be word-processed.
- Awards that have \$\$ beside them also require a **Financial Information Form** (also found at [www.tvdsb.ca/tvef](http://www.tvdsb.ca/tvef)) stapled to **each** application that requires it.
- Some awards require a **Special Application Form** instead of the generic form (see LEGEND).
- **TWO reference letters** must accompany your application. Teachers, coaches, employers, etc. require 2-3 weeks' notice to write these letters. Sample reference letters and reference guide-sheets are available in Guidance.
- Only **ONE** original copy of the two reference letters needs to be provided to Guidance, no matter how many applications are submitted. They should be **signed originals** on letterhead, and include a contact phone number. Do not submit more than two.
- Do not put applications in individual envelopes or folders.
- Staple each application instead of using paperclips.
- Do not fill in the section on the generic form that asks for a credit counselling summary, your grade average, or a teacher signature. These will be completed by Guidance staff.
- Include your SIN number on all applications.
- Check if there are additional requirements for the applications (essays, portfolios, etc.).
- **Submit all applications to Guidance by Thursday, April 9th, unless indicated otherwise in this booklet.**

***Alexandra Hospital Foundation Award.....App***

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- student must be pursuing a career in **health sciences, nursing, medicine, medical lab technology, physiotherapy or a degree in health science**
  - an average of 75% on required subjects (English, Math, Science) as specified in the program at a Canadian post-secondary institution

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***Alexandra Hospital Medical Staff Award.....NoApp***

**Eligibility:** IDCI student

- Criteria:**
- student with the highest standing in SBI 4U1

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***Allison, Trina – Tamara Allison Leavers Memorial Award ..... NoApp***

**Eligibility:** IDCI students who have graduated from the **DE program**

- Criteria:**
- students who have combined achievement with a positive contribution to the school and community

**Selection:** IDCI Principal and DC teachers

***Anderson, Robert and Fern Engineering Award..... App+\$\$***

**Eligibility:** Oxford Area graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- pursuing a Canadian university degree in **engineering**
  - demonstrates academic achievement in both math and science courses
  - preference given to a student with financial need

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee submits two nominees to Oxford County Selection Committee with final approval from donor

***Beaumont, George Memorial Scholarship..... NoApp***

- Criteria:**
- IDCI graduate with the highest standing in **6 university level** courses proceeding to a post-secondary institution

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***Beynon, Gwyn Award ..... App***

**Eligibility:** TVDSB graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- student who has demonstrated leadership and inspired others using **music**.
  - the candidate should demonstrate a passion for and contribution to **music** and inspire those around him/her through his/her passion and his/her consideration and respect for others

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee submits one nominee to TVDSB Committee

***Caffyn, Margaret Memorial Award*..... App**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- two awards for students proceeding to a university or college program
  - leadership skills strongly considered
  - community service
  - academic achievement
  - extra curricular activities and community involvement

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***Canadian Hearing Society Scholarship*..... SA**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- graduating student who is pursuing post-secondary education who has functioned with a hearing loss, demonstrated good citizenship and made a positive contribution to life in the community
  - send **special application form** (available in Guidance or [www.chs.ca/scholarships](http://www.chs.ca/scholarships)) to the Canadian Hearing Society by email no later than **May 1st**

**Selection:** Canadian Hearing Society

***Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters Southwestern Ontario Branch Student Scholarship*..... SA**

**Eligibility:** Southwestern Ontario graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- intending to enter an **apprenticeship in the Industrial Sector** or attend a **manufacturing program** at a college or university
  - academic achievement with emphasis on manufacturing/technological studies courses
  - requires letters of support from tech teachers, co-op employers, etc.
  - **special application form** (available in Guidance) to be submitted by email before **April 9th**

**Selection:** CME Southwestern Ontario

***Carr-Harris, Lloyd Foundation Scholarship*..... App**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- student must be attending university within a year after graduation
  - must have an 85% or better average for six grade 12 university-level courses
  - good citizenship
  - school and community involvement
  - not to be receiving any other “significant” monetary awards

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

**Christie, Charles Trust Award(s) ..... Nom**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- excellent academic and leadership skills
  - perceived as one who may have a high degree of success at the post-secondary level
  - consideration given to students who have received little recognition for their efforts

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

**Compass Canada Group Award ..... App+\$\$**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- graduating student preferably entering, but not restricted to, the area of **hotel management, hospitality and/or food services**
  - financial need is considered

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

**CUPE Local 4222 ..... SA**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- parent must be a CUPE 4222 member
  - must submit a presentation in the form of an essay, poster, or audio clip on “The Importance of Unions in Society”
  - **special application form** (available in Guidance) must be received by **April 30<sup>th</sup>**. Application must be submitted directly to the CUPE 4222 office, Attention: Awards Committee, 544 Clarke Road, London, ON, N5V 3K5

**Selection:** CUPE 4222

**Cryderman, Mackie Award for Excellence in the Arts ..... App**

**Eligibility:** TVDSB graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- demonstrates creative excellence or potential in the **creative, performing and applied arts**
  - will be entering post-secondary program related to the awarded subject
  - plans to practice or perform in their chosen field upon completion of their academic studies. This must be **explained in the application**.

**Selection:** TVDSB System Wide Selection Committee

**Curry, Jane Scholarship..... App+\$\$**

**Eligibility:** Oxford area graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- has shown the ability to set goals and demonstrates determination in reaching these goals
  - has overcome adversity and obstacles in the past
  - has the potential to succeed in their chosen post-secondary program at college or university
  - financial need may be considered
  - special written essay **must** accompany application form
  - see details at [www.tvdsb.ca/tvef](http://www.tvdsb.ca/tvef) under the Student Award and Scholarship Website Directory (choose IDCI from the dropdown box)

**Selection:** committee comprised of six representatives from Oxford County Student Services Departments as well as Nora Thompson, Bonnie Moulton and Fred Curry

**Edmonds, Alex H. Memorial Bursary ..... App**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- awarded to a student who has achieved an academic average of at least 70%
  - has displayed a high level of citizenship and involvement in school activities, including athletics
  - available to all grads regardless of financial need, with preference given to a student who has not already received a major award, scholarship or bursary

**Selection:** IDCI Administration and Guidance

**Evan, Donna Memorial Award..... App+\$\$**

**Eligibility:** female TVDSB graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- female student who is pursuing a career in the trades with clear objectives
  - demonstrates skills related to health and safety
  - diligent, conscientious and industrious with attention to detail
  - displays teamwork
  - preference given to student with financial need

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee to select one application to be forwarded to Evan's Family for award selection

**Emerging Leaders Award (Women's Canadian Club) ..... SA**

**Eligibility:** TVDSB student in **grade 10 or 11**

- Criteria:**
- demonstrated leadership in both school and community
  - **special application form** (available at [www.tvdsb.ca/tvef](http://www.tvdsb.ca/tvef)) to be submitted to Guidance office

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee to select one application to be reviewed by TVDSB System Wide Selection Committee



***Friends of IDCI Award.....Nom***

**Eligibility:** IDCI student

- Criteria:**
- involved in leadership activities
  - recipient should not be an executive member of school clubs

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***General Dynamics Land Systems –Canada Proficiency Awards ..... SA***

**Eligibility:** TVDSB graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- graduate entering post-secondary education
  - **one** proficiency award for a student studying a **skilled trade**
  - **one** proficiency award for a student studying **STEM (science, technology, engineering or mathematics)**
  - **one** proficiency award for a student studying **business/economics**
  - **one** proficiency award for a student studying **arts and social studies**
  - **one** proficiency award for a student who is **supported by a family member in the Canadian Forces or is an active member of the Forces or Cadets**
  - above average academic performance and commitment
  - participation in extracurricular activities, employment and community experience will be considered in addition to academic performance

- student with highest average in all grade 11 and 12 courses

***Global Leadership Award..... App***

**Eligibility:** TVDSB graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- awarded to a student who has acquired global leadership competencies during their secondary school years and contributed to an international awareness in their school (i.e. participated in cross cultural clubs, fairs, trips, ect)
  - must submit a 500 word summary of student’s journey of global learning through their secondary school years (in place of the regular 200 word essay)

**Selection:** TVDSB Awards Committee

***Graham, Amy Memorial Tribute..... S/S Nom***

**Eligibility:** IDCI student

**Criteria:** • a student who has demonstrated perseverance, courage and dignity in the face of adversity and difficult personal challenges

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***Greenslade, John M. Memorial Scholarship..... App+ \$\$***

**Eligibility:** TVDSB graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:** • awarded to one or more students with a disability entering post-secondary education  
• preference given to a student who has exhibited the ability to overcome obstacles and demonstrates financial need

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee submits one nominee to TVDSB Committee

***Haggis, Paul Scholarship ..... App***

**Eligibility:** TVDSB graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:** • registered full-time in any post-secondary **arts** program at **Fanshawe College**  
• participated in extra-curricular fine arts activities  
• fine arts teacher to provide a letter testifying to the candidate's skills and abilities and potential contribution to the community

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee submits one nominee to TVDSB Committee

***Harris, Douglas Family Agricultural Award..... App***

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:** • enrolled in a post-secondary institution in an **agriculture** related program

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***Harris Memorial Bursary..... App+\$\$***

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with 6 university level courses

**Criteria:** • awarded to one of the top students academically who would require financial assistance to continue on to a post-secondary institution in the field of **agriculture or education**

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

**Harvey, Robert Workplace Award..... App**

**Eligibility:** TVDSB graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- has participated in a **cooperative education** course
  - will be leaving secondary school to go directly into the workplace
  - has demonstrated qualities of positive attitude, teamwork and responsibility
  - proof of employment is required (letter from employer)

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee selects up to 3 nominees to forward to TVEF Committee

**Hawkins, Laurie Memorial Bursary..... App**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- proceeding to post-secondary education or apprenticeship
  - strong community involvement
  - respect for authority
  - consideration at all time for the rights of others
  - honesty and truthfulness
  - moral courage
  - mannerly conduct in and out of school

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

**Herbert, J.C. Award..... Nom**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- awarded to a top female and top male graduate
  - proceeding to post-secondary education
  - consideration given to leadership ability, participation in school activities and general contribution to school over the years

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

**Hillis, D.J. Physics Award..... NoApp**

**Eligibility:** IDCI student

- Criteria:**
- student with the highest standing in SPH 4U1

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- awarded to one female and one male graduating student who have contributed to the Athletic Program at IDCI and are continuing their studies at either a college or university

**Criteria:** • a student demonstrating a high degree of critical and analytical thinking while studying LVV 4U1

**Selection:** Mathematics Department

***IDCI Centennial Award (Student Council)*..... Nom**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:** • general overall contribution to the school and has not received another major award

• excellent scholastic achievement, character and ability

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***IMT Scholarship*..... App+\$\$**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:** • pursuing post-secondary in any skilled trade in the field of **manufacturing**

• preference given to a student with financial need

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***Ingersoll Chamber of Commerce Award..... Nom***

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:** ● awarded to a student(s) who promotes qualities exemplified by the Chamber (initiative, positive involvement with school and community, industry, leadership, accomplishment and is a good all-round citizen)

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***Ingersoll Community Foundation Award..... App***

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:** ● a student accepted to any post-secondary institution in the field of **art, science, technology or business** who has shown potential in academic performance during his/her high school years

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***Ingersoll Lions Club Community Service Bursary ..... App***

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:** ● proceeding to a post-secondary institution  
● student who has demonstrated a heart for community service

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***Ingersoll Paper Box Business Award..... App+\$\$***

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:** ● financial need  
● has been employed during high school years  
● well roundedness  
● minimum 75% average in most recent school year  
● is proceeding to a post-secondary program, preferably in the field of **business**

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***Johnston, Deborah Award..... App***

**Eligibility:** grade 11 or 12 IDCI female student

**Criteria:** ● **female** student who has taken one or more of the following grade 11 or 12 level technology courses: **electrical, communications, manufacturing, construction, transportation or welding**  
● student who has done well academically but more importantly has shown an 'eagerness' to learn

**Selection:** Technological Studies Department

***Kikkert Family Bursary* ..... NoApp**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- awarded to a student with improved attendance over his/her years at IDCI
  - consideration also given to overall improvement in performance, attitude, and effort
  - candidate seen as being likely to use the award to further personal growth

**Selection:** Vice-Principal

***King, V.B. Engineering Bursary/Scholarship* ..... App+\$\$**

**Eligibility:** TVDSB graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- must be enrolled in **engineering** at a Canadian university
  - proficient academically
  - financial need
  - keen interest in engineering

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee submits one nominee to TVDSB Awards Committee – V.B. King Selection Committee

***Kiwanis Club of Ingersoll Bursary*..... SA**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- candidate proceeding to a post-secondary institute
  - based on 40% financial need, 15% academic achievement, 45% school, family and community involvement, and personal growth
  - submit **special application form** (available in Guidance office)

**Selection:** Kiwanis Club selects up to 3 recipients

***Kiwanis Club of Ingersoll Technological Studies Award* ..... SA**

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- candidate proceeding to an apprenticeship or college program with a **technology** emphasis
  - based on 40% financial need, 15% academic achievement, 45% school, family and community involvement, and personal growth
  - submit **special application form** (available in Guidance office)

**Selection:** Kiwanis Club

***Kiwanis Citizenship Award..... S/S***

**Eligibility:** student in grade 12 who has completed a full year at IDCI

- Criteria:**
- respect for authority
  - consideration at all time for the rights of others
  - participation in school athletics and other activities, demonstrating good sportsmanship
  - honestly and truthfulness
  - moral courage
  - readiness to forgive an offense
  - efficiency in academic standing
  - mannerly conduct in and out of school
  - exemplification of the Kiwanis motto, “We Build” in connection with collegiate citizenship

**Selection:** IDCI staff and students vote

***Kiwanis Mel Osbourne Youth Scholarship..... NoApp***

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- awarded to a student on the basis of acceptable grades, good character and financial need
  - membership and participation in a Kiwanis Service Leadership Club (**Key Club**) and demonstrated community service involvement

**Selection:** Key Club Teacher-Advisor and Kiwanis Club

***Knights of Columbus Bursary ..... App + \$\$***

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- awarded to one male and one female student proceeding to college or university for the next school year
  - financial need is considered
  - awarded to a student who has overcome obstacles but has still managed to keep up with his/her academics
  - has exhibited improved citizenship skills

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***Lieutenant Governor Community Volunteer Award ..... NoApp***

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

- Criteria:**
- awarded to a student who not only completes the number of volunteer hours required to graduate, but who goes above and beyond

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***London and District Stroke Recovery Assistance Bursary ..... App***

**Eligibility:** TVDSB student of any grade

**Criteria:** ● for students who have experienced a stroke of Transient Ischemic Attack  
● fund may assist with education or current rehabilitation

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee submits one nominee to TVDSB Committee

***London Home Builders' Association Award of Merit ..... App***

**Eligibility:** TVDSB graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:** ● awarded to a graduating student from a **construction technology** program entering the work force full time in **construction**  
● demonstrates aptitude and interest through active learning within the program  
● encourages teamwork through co-operating, collaboration and trust  
● accepts responsibility for individual and team outcomes

**Selection:** London Home Builders

***Martineau, Claire Memorial Award..... App***

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:** ● has been an active, enthusiastic participant in the IDCI **music** program  
● has demonstrated a positive attitude, a love of music, and an appreciation for the arts  
● priority goes to a student who has decided to study **music** at the post-secondary level.

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee and Music Department

***Masters, Brad Music Memorial Scholarship ..... App***

**Eligibility:** Oxford County area graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:** ● student pursuing post-secondary education in **instrumental music studies or strings major** (must identify principle instrument of study)  
● displays spirit and integrity  
● is honest and ambitious  
● displays characteristics of leadership and team play  
● demonstrates exemplary qualities in fellowship, scholarship, and sportsmanship.

**Selection:** Oxford Awards Selection Committee in consultation with members of the Masters family



***Masters, Brad Technology Memorial Scholarship..... App***

**Eligibility:** Oxford County area graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:**

- student pursuing post-secondary education/training in the **woodworking** field
- displays honesty, spirit and integrity
- displays characteristics of leadership and team play
- demonstrates exemplary qualities in fellowship, scholarship, and sportsmanship.

**Selection:** Oxford Awards Selection Committee in consultation with members of the Masters family

***Matthews, Harold Entrepreneurial Business Award..... App***

**Eligibility:** IDCI graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:**

- proceeding to post-secondary studies in a **business** program
- considered a self-starter
- preference to a student in an **entrepreneurial** course

**Selection:** IDCI Awards Committee

***McArthur, Betty Art Scholarship..... App***

**Eligibility:** IDCI or Woodstock graduate with an OSSD

**Criteria:**

- Submit all applications to Guidance by **Thursday, April 9th**, unless indicated otherwise in this booklet.
- Application forms can be downloaded and should be word-processed
- Do not put applications in individual envelopes or folders.
- Staple each application instead of using paperclips.
- Include a separate Financial Application Form for every award with a **\$\$ symbol**.
- Do not fill in the section on the application form that asks for a credit counselling summary, your grade average, or a teacher signature. These will be completed by Guidance Staff.
- Submit only one copy of the two reference letters, even if multiple applications are submitted.
- Do not submit more than two reference letters.
- Ask your references early to write your letters in order to give them time (teachers require 2-3 weeks).
- Reference letters should be signed originals on letterhead, and should include a contact phone number.
- Sample reference letters and reference guide-sheets are available in Guidance.
- Include your SIN number on all applications.
- Be sure to submit any additional requirements for the applications (essays, portfolios, etc.).
- Submit community hours sheets to Guidance before May 1<sup>st</sup> to be considered for awards that recognize community involvement.
