## *Awards, Bursaries & Scholarships Information*

- 1) All of the awards are listed alphabetically
- 2) These awards are administered through either:
  - Ingersoll District Collegiate Institute
  - the Thames Valley Education Foundation [www.tvdsb.ca/tvef](http://www.tvdsb.ca/tvef)
  - private community organizations and donors
- 3) Additional scholastic awards include:
  - Highest Standing** -
    - students with the highest mark in grade 12 courses will receive a recognition award donated by an individual, group or business within the Ingersoll community
    - students with the highest standing in grade 9, 10 and 11 courses will receive a certificate
  - Honour Roll** - students achieving an 80%+ average overall in the school year will receive a certificate
    - Grades 9 and 10: all eight courses
    - Grade 11: best seven courses
    - Grade 12: best six courses
  - Ontario Scholar** – students achieving a grade of at least 80% in six grade 12 courses at the university, university/college, college, workplace, or open level will receive a certificate
- 4) This table is accurate at publishing date, but awards may change.
- 5) Many post-secondary institutions offer scholarships and bursaries, either automatically based on your average, or for which you must apply. Carefully check the website of your college/university for the latest updates and check with your institution's Financial Aid Office.

# How to Apply

- Identify awards you qualify for based on award criteria.
- Check to see which type of application form is required.
- Download the general **Student Award Application** [here](#).
- The downloaded general application form can be filled in and saved for each award. The 200–500 word essay should be customized based on the criteria for each award.
- Do not fill in the section that asks for a credit counselling summary, your grade average, or a teacher signature. These will be completed by Guidance staff.
- Some awards also require a **Financial Information** form. It can be downloaded [here](#) and must be submitted for each award that requires it.
- Some awards require a **Special Application** form instead of the general form (listed in the table below).
- TWO reference letters** must be submitted which will be used for all your awards applications. **Teachers, coaches, employers, etc. must be given 2-3 weeks' notice to write these letters. Ask them early!** Letters should be **signed** and on letterhead, or if that is not possible, they must include a contact phone number.

- Email a scanned copy of each of your two reference letters to [ingersoll@tvdsb.ca](mailto:ingersoll@tvdsb.ca) or bring them to the Guidance Office. No more than two letters will be accepted.
- Sample reference letters are posted in the Grad Google Classroom.
- Submit award applications to the Grad Google Classroom **by April 8th**, unless otherwise indicated. Find the folder for the award and drop the application form(s) in. Only PDF copies of the applications will be accepted.
- Check if there are additional requirements for the applications (essays, portfolios, etc.) and submit those with the application forms.
- Students who drop applications into every folder will not be considered for any awards. Be sure you check the award criteria before submitting.

**Deadline is April 8th, unless indicated otherwise.**

## How to Apply

- Identify awards you qualify for based on award criteria.
- Check to see which type of application form is required.
- Download the general **Student Award Application** [here](#).
- The downloaded general application form can be filled in and saved for each award. The 200-500 word essay should be customized based on the criteria for each award.
- Do not fill in the section that asks for a credit counselling summary, your grade average, or a teacher signature. These will be completed by Guidance staff.
- Some awards also require a **Financial Information** form. It can be downloaded [here](#) and must be submitted for each award that requires it.
- Some awards require a **Special Application** form instead of the general form (listed in the table below).
- TWO reference letters** must be submitted which will be used for all your awards applications. Teachers, coaches, employers, etc. must be given 2-3 weeks' notice to write these letters. Ask them early! Letters should be **signed** and on letterhead, or if that is not possible, they must include a contact phone number.

- Email a scanned copy of each of your two reference letters to [ingersoll@tvdsb.ca](mailto:ingersoll@tvdsb.ca) or bring them to the Guidance Office. No more than two letters will be accepted.
- Sample reference letters are posted in the Grad Google Classroom.
- Submit award applications to the Grad Google Classroom **by April 8th**, unless otherwise indicated. Find the folder for the award and drop the application form(s) in. Only PDF copies of the application will be accepted.
- Check if there are additional requirements for the applications (essays, portfolios, etc.) and submit those with the application forms.
- Students who drop applications into every folder will not be considered for any awards. Be sure you check the award criteria before submitting.
